K. Patterson reminded those present to work on their respective program mapping, as they are due at the end of the month.

## VIe. TV/Video Department Name Change

M. Taylor reviewed bullet points on a PowerPoint presentation that explained the reasons he is seeking a department name change. Changing the department name from Television and Video Communications to Digital Media would align their curriculum with numerous high schools and 4-year programs. Digital Media is innovative, efficient and provides growth whereas Television and Video Communications is archaic, not

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reflective of their current program and not in-line with high school and university descriptors. He further stated that their Advisory Board unanimously supported the name change.

B. Sos and CIC Committee Members requested that M. Taylor reach out to Department Chairs across the college to inform all of the department name change. This will ensure that any programs that may be affected by the name change process curriculum accordingly.

The name change will be reflected in the 2020-2021 catalog.

## VII. ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION 4023 – Hours and Units

SCC is requesting support to add an exception clause to AR 4023 for their Apprenticeship Program. After discussion, committee requested additional time to review request. Item will be further discussed at the November 19<sup>th</sup> CIC Meeting.

# VIII. ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION 4235 – Credit By Examination

SCC is pursuing support in amending AR 4235. SCC wants to include language that states a student must be enrolled in 1 credit course in order to earn college credit and gain their completed articulated ROP high school course (Career Transition Articulated Pathways/Credit By Exam). Discussion will continue on November 19<sup>th</sup>.

## IX. OTHER

Discussion ensued about the possibility of adding a second discipline to courses, with different faculty minimum qualifications teaching the same course and how they can be recorded in Colleague. B. Sos will do research and report back to committee.

B. Sos stated that RSCCD's standard prerequisite validation requires the faculty in the discipline or department provide a course outline of record of at least three CSU's or UC's which reflects in their catalog that they offer the equivalent course with the equivalent prerequisite. He further mentioned that for non-English or non-math courses that use English or math as a prerequisite also require statistical validation that is to be performed (and kept) in the departments every four years. B. Sos will email language to all CIC members on validations and requested feedback on their interpretation.

Outside hour dialogue resulted after a Course of Record (COR) from Fire Academy was reviewed.
