V. CIC Chair's Report

a. General Information

M. Grant stated that courses must include a representative textbook, materials, OER / ZTC in all Course Outline of Records (CORs) until CIC has further discussions on the subject.

M. Grant updated the committee on the work being done by the Course Enrollment Maximum Committee (CEM). She explained that four (4) smaller groups have been created which consist of Distance Education, Lecture, Lab/Performance/Production and Process. A proposal is expected to be completed in Spring 2024.

S. Butler acknowledged that, if this position is hired, the focus will rely mainly on the Outcomes duties for the first year to year and a half and not so much in curriculum.
