V. Chair's Report

A. Faculty Training

K. Robinson reminded faculty that Curriculum Professional Development (PD) Workshops will take place on Wednesdays and Fridays throughout March and most of April. She encouraged faculty to attend if they need assistance with course or program proposals. Attendees will receive PD credit. Please register through SAC's PD Gateway.

K. Robinson encouraged faculty interested in serving as a Common Course Numbering (CCN) lead to submit their names to CIC leadership.

VI. Discussion Item

A. Faculty Minimum Qualifications

K. Robinson mentioned that she was unable to compile the information she had intended to present. However, she provided a brief overview of the challenges divisions face in hiring adjunct faculty for a subject, where Human Resources believes the candidates do not meet the minimum qualifications.

B. Curriculum Process Review

K. Robinson mentioned that a pause on the quadrennial review process for one year is being considered. The purpose is to allow CIC leadership and Curriculum Office staff time to gather more information on upcoming state initiatives regarding the integration of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) and accessibility into the Course Outline of Record (COR). This pause would enable courses currently scheduled for quadrennial review to incorporate DEI and accessibility updates next year, avoiding the need for immediate revisions when new guidelines become available. Additionally, it would provide faculty the opportunity to submit more meaningful courses and programs, making the process more manageable.

The pause would exclude courses and programs that have failed to submit their quadrennial reviews on time. New and revised courses and programs for career education, noncredit, common course numbering, general education petitions or any faculty wishing to proceed with their course or program review are welcome to do so.

Discussion ensued.

- J. Lamb stated that resources are available to support the new process if faculty choose to proceed.
- K. Robinson asked CIC representatives to consult with their constituents and share their feedback at the next meeting.
