V. Chair's Report

a. Apprenticeship Courses and Programs

i. Cross-Listing

ii. Department of Labor (DOL)vs. Department of Apprenticeship Standards (DAS) Approval K. Robinson explained that apprenticeship programs must receive approval from both the Department of Labor (DOL) and the Department of Apprenticeship Standards (DAS). She emphasized that DAS approval is necessary to ensure proper funding for these programs. She also clarified that cross-listing courses under similar prefixes created specifically for apprenticeships is unnecessary, as it adds extra work for faculty and the Curriculum Office. While courses can be created under apprenticeship-specific prefixes, this is optional rather than required. She also outlined the process

for creating course sections for both apprenticeship and non-apprenticeship students.

Discussion ensued.

VI. Action Item – First Read

a. Baccalaureate Upper-Level General Education Courses

D. Peraza presented three possible options for the prerequisite/limitation of enrollment statement for upper-division courses within the baccalaureate programs and requested feedback from the committee. The Technology department voted in favor of Option 1 but indicated they may reconsider Option 2 in the future. Counseling, Sciences, Student Services, and J. Lamb voted in support of Option 2.

Representatives were asked to consult with their constituents once more, as a vote on the matter will take place at the November 24th meeting.

b. Certificate of Achievement Residency Requirement for Apprenticeships

D. Peraza and A. Maricic delivered a PowerPoint presentation proposing the addition of language to the Certificate of Achievement residency requirement to include apprenticeship programs. The proposed language specifies that students must complete at least two courses from an approved registered apprenticeship program, approximately 20% of the total required units, to be eligible to receive a certificate from SAC or SCC.

VII. Other

K. Robinson shared that noncredit requested the Correspondence Education addenda be made public. She asked if anyone on the council had any concerns or wished to discuss the matter. No concerns were raised.
