# IV. DISCUSSION: FULLY ONLINE by MUTUAL AGREEMENT (FOMA) DEFINITION (First Read)

B. Sos asked for feedback on the FOMA definition. Respondents mentioned that the document read well as written.

# V.a. Accreditation Report

F. Ortiz reported that accreditation is moving along. M. Zarske is reaching out to co-leads to provide facilitation and guidance on what to do with evidence and templates. He also stated that the first draft will be completed in early December providing editors an opportunity to fine-tune it in January.

# V.b. Articulation Report

P. Canzona emphasized that courses approved at the local level for General Education (GE) plans B (CSU-GE) and C (IGETC) will have to wait for CSUs and UCs to approve them for official inclusion. Students who take a course that is not CSU/UC approved for CSU-GE and/or IGETC will not earn GE credit and there is no petition

process. She cautioned faculty about offering courses intended for GE credit (Plans B and/or C) prior to their GE approval.

# V.c. currlQunet META Update

R. Vazquez stated that conversations regarding the catalog module have begun with Governet.

# V.d. Guided Pathways (GP)

- S. Clark informed the committee that on Friday the National Center for Inquiry Improvement observe the GP work and facilitate discussions with the Transition Teams to develop a targeted plan on the team's goals and priorities for the upcoming year. She added that the Transitions Teams' next scheduled meeting is December 21<sup>st</sup> at 11:00 a.m.
- S. Clark remarked that the Transition Teams is focusing on the transition from high school to credit programs, noncredit to credit, and adult education. She invited anyone interested to participate in this endeavor.
- S. Clark informed the committee of upcoming Webinars scheduled for November 13<sup>th</sup> and November 20<sup>th</sup>. The Webinars will be focused on redesigning career and equity. She will forward an email with details and expressed hopefulness that CIC members will join in the conversations.

# VI. OTHER

- B. Sos stated that SAC and SCC have agreed to approve the Board Policy (BP) and Administrative Regulation (AR) pertaining to Credit for Prior Learning with minor changes. He explained that AR 4236 was essentially copied and pasted into AR 4235. Redundancy of information was removed, and a comment was added to direct students to each campus' policies and procedures information within the individual college catalog.
- P. Canzona added that AR 4236 was reduced and modified to provide clarification and avoid confusion in CLEP, ID, and IP credit. It was reorganized in a way that made more sense and read better.
- B. Sos commented that the AR will be discussed at the Academic Senate on Tuesday, November 10<sup>th</sup>.
- B. Sos reported that he is revising the Curriculum and Instruction Council Handbook. He mentioned that he will email the work-in-progress copy to all CIC members for their review and input. He added that details will be outlined in the email of what highlighted text and text in red within the document represent.
