Learn the procedures, management, and expectations of working in private dance studios. Applicable for both the dance educator and the professional dancer. CSU

DNCE 270 Dance Practicum

Unit(s): 1.0 Class Hours: 9.0 Lecture, 27.0 Lab total.
Prerequisite: DNCE 180 with a minimum grade of C.

Directed study at selected locations providing workplace experience as performer, choreographer, production assistant, dance management intern, dance team assistant, dance studio assistant, dance teacher, or somatics teaching assistant.
