**Student Resources**: Video tapes/CD's are available in the MSC and library. Tutorial software is available on the computers in the MC (Math Center hours to be determined) Website "Interact Math". The Math Center will be open during intersession from 10-6pm located in the L-building second floor.

**Student Learning Outcomes:** Students will be able to use linear equations in one variable to correctly solve basic word problems by the end of the semester.

**Grades:** Grades will be determined by earning points. 90-100% of the total points equals an "A", 80-89% is a "B", 70-79% is a "C". If you earn below 70% of the total points you will not pass the class, and it must be repeated to move on.

<u>Exams:</u> We will have 3 exams. , each worth 100 points, and a 200 point comprehensive Final Exam. You will need an Apperson 100AS form for the multiple choice part of the final.

Quizzes: Quizzes are given daily, except exam days. Each quiz is 10 points. Usually a total of 8-12 quizzes will be given during the course.

<u>Homework:</u> Each homework section should be done on separate paper. Write the section and problems at the top of the page. When homework is collected it will be graded for completeness and accuracy. Show your work! A list of answers will not earn any points. Homework will be collected on the day of the exam. Each packet is worth 20 points. Because of the nature of Intersession and the pace that must be followed, you may elect to be graded based only on Quizzes, Exams and Class work.

<u>Class work:</u> Problems worked in class or worksheets will be randomly collected. (2-5 points) Students must be present to earn these points.

Notebook: Students should keep a notebook. I recommend a 3 ring binder where all HW, handouts and materials can be kept.
