

Bachelor of Science in Occupational Studies
Applicant Instructions - Fall 2025

The Occupational Studies (OS) program will be admitting a total of 30 students for baccalaureate program Fall 2025. The OS Program accepts application on a rolling basis. To be considered for Fall 2025, application must be received by June 30, 2025. Any application received on or after July 1, 2025 will be considered for Fall 2026 admission.

The prerequisite for applying to the OS program is graduation from an OTA program that has ACOTE accreditation.

Steps to completing the application to the OS Baccalaureate Program:

1. Apply to Santa Ana College (even if you are a Santa Ana College Student) - Choose Occupational Studies |BS| SAC in the Intended Major area.
2. Obtain official transcripts for classes taken from all colleges except SAC or SCC. Transcripts must be in sealed envelope from the college. DO NOT send your transcripts directly to Admission & Records. If you have any difficulties with obtaining paper copies of your official transcripts, please email ota@sac.edu for further instructions.
3. Make an appointment with OS Counselor, Joanna Campos for a transcripts review.
To make an appointment:
 - a. Please call the career center staff at 714-564-7654 and ask to meet with an OS counselor. Here is the link to the career center:

 - b. Click on "Live Chat with Career Center Staff", call during hours of operation, or email CareerCTECenter@sac.edu with your name, student ID number, reason for appointment, and preferred times/dates for the appointment. Please indicate that you are requesting OS counseling services.
4. Download and complete the Occupational Studies application from the website.
5. Submit the application to the OS program in one sealed 9" x 14" envelope that includes:
 - a. Student application
 - b. Student application checklist
 - c. Official transcripts
6. Mail your application packet using the following address. Application packet must be postmarked by June 30, 2025.
