Mapping curriculum – group definition: pre-reqs, core requirements... planning it out (sequencing within each semester for availability)</p> <p>*Mapping is available in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- transfer programs through counseling</li> <li>-some faculty</li> <li>- athletics, Freshman X, transfer programs – with counselor</li> <li>- criminal justice, (AA – GE List/AAT)</li> <li>- CTE (nursing, fire tech, welding)</li> <li>-online business degree</li> </ul>	<p>-We need to map the classes that have to be taken by students, have a schedule the students have to take and make classes available so that they can complete it within a certain period of time.</p>	<p>Cross-discipline faculty, counselors, deans, chairs, individuals who schedule the classes, need one champion for each cluster (each semester this person advocates for the classes that are needed - we have an example of this through Distance Learning – Cherylee Kushida), need to survey students to find out when their schedule is free to take classes, and facilities.</p>	<p>Classroom space at all times, faculty (FT/PT), funding to cover all of the expenses, facilities, discipline counselors, technology, more efficient and less cumbersome electronic ed plan software program , service learning/internship opportunities attached to the programs, and others.</p>

#### B. Plan of Action

Online degree pathway – with three different degrees – required orientation (every semester), get into a track, follow the track once you are in it.

There are escape clauses to allow students to make up classes if they fall behind. Distance Learning – cross-disciplined and they have an advocate.
